THE 3 STEPS TOWARDS ECRAID

- ECRAID-Base (European Clinical Research Alliance for Infectious Diseases) continues the activities of PREPARE, COMBACTE, VALUE-Dx, RECOVER and ECRAID-Plan.
- 2. **ECRAID** will become an independent non-for-profit legal entity in 2021.
- 3. **ECRAID-Base** is the initial set of activities for **ECRAID**.

As a European clinical research network **ECRAID-Base** will generate rigorous evidence to improve diagnosis, prevention and treatment of infections and to better respond to EID threats.

ECRAID-Base Launches European Clinical Research Alliance

Utrecht, Wednesday February 24th – Following the signing of the Grant Agreement by the European Commission (EC), ECRAID-Base has secured funding of 30 million euros and will commence March 1st 2021. ECRAID-Base is the core set of activities for ECRAID (the European Clinical Research Alliance for Infectious Diseases), which aspires to become the first of its kind, pan-European clinical research network for infectious diseases in Europe. Over the five-year duration of ECRAID-Base, ECRAID will evolve into a self-sustaining, not-for-profit organisation conducting clinical research for both public and private sponsors.
